GRADUATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Graduate Degree Requirements

- a. Completion of all coursework specified by the graduate program.
- b. Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or higher if specified by the graduate program.
- c. Submission of all pre-graduation materials required by the graduate program.
- d. Acceptance of thesis or other required final project by the graduate program.
- e. Submission of two copies of approved thesis or project in a specified form together with payment of binding fee where applicable.
- f. Submission of Application for Graduation and payment of any graduation fees assessed by the university.
- g. In the case of certification programs, submission of all governmental forms.
- h. Residency Requirement: A minimum of 25% percent of the total credits required for the completion of the graduate degree or postbaccalaureate certificate or credential must be earned at Aurora University. Individual programs may establish more extensive residency requirements, including requirements that specific coursework be completed at Aurora University.
