

GRADUATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Graduate Degree Requirements

- a. Completion of all coursework specified by the graduate program.
- b. Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or higher if specified by the graduate program.
- c. Submission of all pre-graduation materials required by the graduate program.
- d. Acceptance of thesis or other required final project by the graduate program.
- e. Submission of two copies of approved thesis or project in a specified form together with payment of binding fee where applicable.
- f. Submission of Application for Graduation and payment of any graduation fees assessed by the university.
- g. In the case of certification programs, submission of all governmental forms.
- h. Residency Requirement: A minimum of 25% percent of the total credits required for the completion of the graduate degree or post-baccalaureate certificate or credential must be earned at Aurora University. Individual programs may establish more extensive residency requirements, including requirements that specific coursework be completed at Aurora University.
